Rehearsal Audience

Symphonic Encounters is an open rehearsal series, which means that attendees observe the orchestra preparing for a regular season concert. Our suggested age range for this program is from grade 6 up to adults. Please contact the Education Assistant if you require further information.

Rehearsal Time

Each rehearsal begins promptly at 10am. Doors open at 9:15am and we request that everyone be seated inside the theatre by 9:50am. Late-comers will not be seated until an appropriate break in the rehearsal.

Rehearsal Length

Rehearsals run from 10am-12:30pm with a rehearsal break that is usually called between 11:15 and 11:30am.

Meet a Musician

During the break, a VSO musician will be available to answer any questions students may have about a career in music or the rehearsal process.

Orpheum Tours

A 40-minute tour of the Orpheum Theatre is available as an alternative to sitting in on the second half of the rehearsal. Space is limited, so advance booking is required.
